CHINA EXCHANGE —SPRING BREAK 2019

We are looking for dedicated and enthusiastic students to be part of our long standing exchange program to Nankai High School in Tianjin, China. This is a 2 week trip that will take place during Spring Break 2019. Sardis students will billet a student from Nankai High school for 2 weeks at the end of January and the beginning of February. Sardis students will then travel to China for 2 weeks during Spring Break. Students will typically spend 10 days in Tianjin, where they will be billeted with the family of the Nankai student who stayed with them. During a 3-4 day tour of Beijing and the surrounding area, students will be accommodated in a hotel. Students are required to have good work habits, attendance and satisfactory academic standing. 
