In order to provide ongoing, consistent and long-term support for our At Home Learning students that will:

- provide a wide array of courses that support personal choice and interest
- support the graduation and post-secondary plans of individual At Home Learners
- allow students to work beyond the Octet/5-week timeline to complete a course successfully
- provide face-to-face support in a small group setting with no requirement to enter the main building
- continue to maintain a connection to Sardis while continuing as an At-Home Learner
- facilitate a gradual return to Sardis Secondary in future octets

the following opportunity is available for current Sardis Secondary At Home Learners:

- Counsellors and/or VPs will meet virtually with students/family to assist in enrolling in a Distance Learning course from an accredited British Columbia DL school that meets their interest and graduation requirements/goals.
- students will have the opportunity for a weekly drop-in morning or afternoon on-site support located in a portable separate from the main building with a small group of physically distanced students. **Please note: masks are required at all times for staff and students in this classroom.**
- students will have the opportunity to rejoin Sardis Secondary at the start of a new Octet for the remainder of the year or continue with a new DL course.
