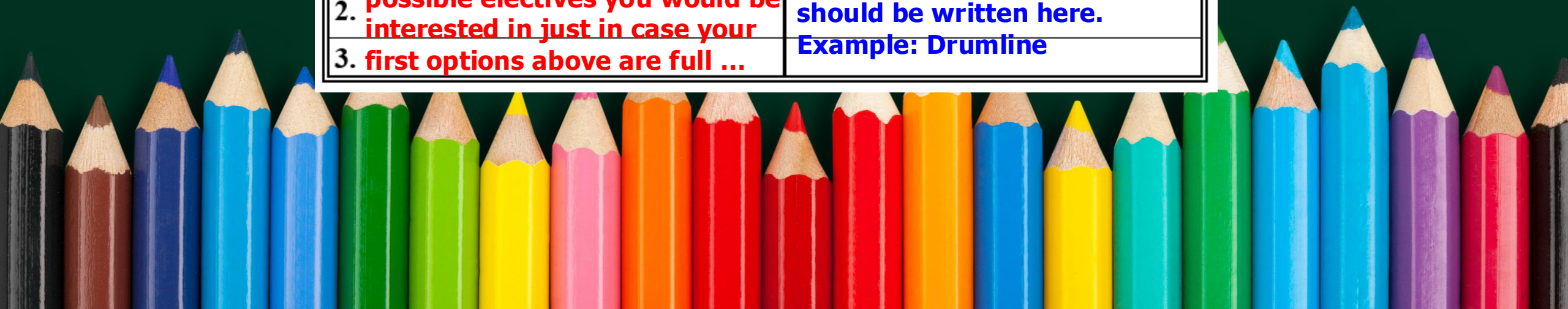

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

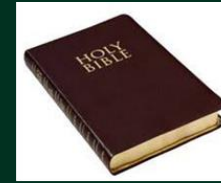
HIGH SCHOOL ASSESSMENTS
