Provincial Assessments, Assessment week

- Provincial Assessments for Numeracy 10 were done in January with students enrolled in Science 10. Next sessions are currently scheduled for April 7-8 (Lit 10 and 12) and June (Numeracy 10 and cleanup).
- November results:
 - o Lit 10: above district and province percent of students scoring 3, above district for scoring 4
 - o Lit 12: above district percent of students scoring 3 or 4, below provincial percent scoring 3 and 4
- Still only UBC uses Lit 12 as entrance requirement. No other BC universities have indicated similar use of this assessment.
