## MINISTRY OF EDUCATION GRADUATION REQUIRMENTS

- 1. MUST HAVE A TOTAL OF 80 CREDITS
  - 1 course = 4 credits
  - Must complete all required courses at each grade level
  - 16 credits must be at the Grade 12 Level
- 2. MUST HAVE A FINE ARTS OR APPLIED SKILLS COURSE

(almost all electives are one or the other check course calendar)

3. MUST COMPLETE CAREER-LIFE CONNECTIONS (CLC)

Students will develop a well-balanced meal plan and a complete strength training plan as major projects.

• This course is very adaptable so is beneficial for every fitness level.


