

The June school restart saw almost 200,000 students safely return to the classroom in the Province of British Columbia. Educators and school staff have gone above and beyond to find innovative ways to support students, and we've heard so many heart-warming stories of how meaningful this support was for students and families.

Minister of Education, Rob Fleming, has appointed a steering committee with representatives from teachers, parents, First Nations, support staff, principals and vice-principals, school boards and trustees, and public health representatives that will be active over the summer. Its mandate is to learn from best practices from March to June, identify existing/potential issues and propose solutions based on different scenarios, and support the development of parent and teacher resources.

The Ministry of Education will provide an announcement in August, regarding the restart plan for schools in September.
